

## **\*\*2009-10 BPAA ELEMENTARY BASKETBALL SEASON OVERVIEW \*\***

The Cities of Brooklyn Park & Brooklyn Center form the Brooklyn Park Basketball Program, offering House League Basketball for elementary boys & girls in grades 2-5, and girls in 6<sup>th</sup> grade. (Boys in 6<sup>th</sup> grade will play in the Jr High league.)

The program emphasizes fun and equal participation for all players. Teams are comprised of 7-9 players engaging in practices, skills events, games and the season-end tournament. Registration occurs in September and the program runs from November-March.

### **Registration Dates:**

### **Registration Fees and Volunteer Hours:**

- Grades 2-5, & 6<sup>th</sup> grade girls** (Elementary House League) \$85.00 + 3-5 volunteer hours

### **Registration Process:**

- There are 2 ways to register for the program:

### **Teams Assigned – Elementary Schools:**

- Coaches and teams will be assigned during the month of October. Players are assigned by school and grade to form teams. Requests for certain coaches and/or players may not be guaranteed.

### **Practices and Games – Elementary Schools:**

- **Practices:** Practices will start the week of November 2<sup>nd</sup>. Practices are held on weekdays, usually for one hour between 6:00-9:00 p.m. Players will be notified by their coach when and where practices will be held.
- **Games:** Games will start on Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup> 2009. The majority of games will be played on Friday evenings. Coaches will distribute the team jersey and game schedule listing the dates, times and locations. 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade divisions play in an instructional league during the first part of the season, followed by regular league games. 5<sup>th</sup> grade (boys and girls) and 6<sup>th</sup> grade (girls) division will play twelve game schedule. Games run for one hour between the hours of 6:00-9:30 p.m.

### **Year-end Tournament – Elementary Schools:**

- The season-end tournament will run from 6:00-10:00 p.m. on Friday March 12, 2010 from 8:00 a.m. -10:00 pm. on Saturday, March 13<sup>th</sup>. Games may be played on Sunday March 14<sup>th</sup> as well if needed.

### **Important Considerations:**

**Financial assistance:** Will be available on a limited basis only at the start of the season. To apply, you must register in person at the Brooklyn Park Community Center. A picture ID and most recent W2 form are required to qualify for financial aid. We do not give full scholarships in the program and the remainder of the fee must be paid at the time of registration

**Late registrations:** Will be accepted for an additional \$25.00 fee. Players will be placed on teams with openings and will need to attend 2 practices prior to participating in games.

**Refunds:** Will only be issued prior to the start of games. A \$25.00 processing fee will be deducted from the original fee amount for each player removed from the program. Refunds will be processed in late November. No exceptions.

**Playing Up:** This option is not allowed in the BPAA basketball program.
