

**BROOKLYN AREA BASKETBALL
TEAM SELECTION RULES
(COACHES DRAFT)**

1. The draft will take 1 hour from start to finish.
2. Coaches will have 1 minute to make their round selection. This applies to any given round.
3. To start the draft, the assigned coach for each team will select a card to determine the order of which coach gets to go first in selecting the player for their first round pick. The coach with card #1 will be the coach to go first, then the coach with card #2, and so on.
4. For the second round, each coach will pick in the reverse order of the previous round.
5. The third and fourth rounds will be used to add the coach's and assistant coach's child to their team roster. **NOTE: Only one coach and one assistant for the team will have this option allowed.**
6. For the fifth round, the coach with card #1 will go first again, and then for subsequent rounds, the order will be reversed back and forth.
7. All players attending the try-outs are to be picked first. Players having signed up that are not in attendance will be picked last.
8. The draft will be completed when all players noted on the roster are assigned to teams.
9. Players signing up after the draft will be assigned to teams by the Commissioner, not by the coaches.

NOTE:

- All teams will have 8-10 players.
- There is no rule which limits the number of players from your last year's team given the coach selects players individually during his/her draft round.
- After the draft is completed, the list will be signed off by the coach and commissioner.
- Once teams are known, please reach out to your players, introduce yourself and let them know the practice schedule.
